## 2021 Leveraged Project Call Now Open

Project Proposals due October 26, 2020

*Your team of small businesses can access free technical assistance from national laboratory scientists and engineers*

**NMSBA Leveraged Projects** allow multiple small businesses that share technical challenges to request assistance collectively for a larger project. Leveraged projects should focus on helping NM small businesses solve a specific technical challenge and must be completed within one year. Funding is competitive and ranges from \$40,000 - \$120,000 per project. Projects that are well defined, achievable, and relevant to the stated problem faced by the businesses stand a greater chance of being funded.
